- 1. Objective : The annual International Fireworks Display Contest illuminates the night sky over Macao and intertwines with the emotions of event-goers. In September and October this year, on five evenings of Saturdays and the National Day of the People's Republic of China, two sessions of fireworks display accompanied by music, prepared by the participating teams will boost the overall ambience and adorn the skyline of the city. In celebration of the 31st Macau International Fireworks Display Contest held after the pandemic, the "Student Drawing Contest" is organized by Macao Government Tourism Office to inspire creativity among the youth, and to brighten up such iconic event with their unique drawing.
- 2. Theme : 31st Macau International Fireworks Display Contest
- 3. The contest, organized by Macao Government Tourism Office and administered by Macau Artist Society, welcomes participation from local student (with a valid student ID issued by Macau Education and Youth Development Bureau), except employees of the Tourism Office, members of the judging panel, and their families.
- 4. Categories : Group A : Age 6 10 (born in 2013 2017)
 - Group B : Age 11 14 (born in 2009 2012) Group C : Age 15 – 18 (born in 2005 – 2008)

Group D : Age 19 or above (born in or before 2004)

- 5. Artwork Medium : No restrictions
 - Artwork Dimension : 39X54cm (4K)
- 6. Submission Dates : September 9,2023 to October 31, 2023 23:59

8. Submission of artwork

Students must enroll as an individual. Students who have registered to participate should take a photo or scan their artwork on or before October 31, 2023 (in JPG format, with a high-resolution image file of not less than 2MB)and send the files and entry form by email to mas28532857@gmail.com. The organizing committee will provide a confirmation reply upon receipt of the submission. Complaints regarding lost submissions due to oversized attachments will not be accepted.

- 9. Numbers of Entries : Each applicant only submit one piece of drawing.
- 10. Evaluation Procedures : The submitted artworks will go through two rounds of selection. If they pass the first round, Macau Artist Society will notify the relevant students by phone and SMS to submit their physical artwork to Macau Artist Society (Address: Avenida do Conselheiro Ferreira de Almeida No. 49, Edificio SAN HEI KOC FL1 FLAT C, D, Macao; Office hours: Monday to Friday, 10:00 AM to 5:00 PM) or submit collectively at their respective schools (Macao Art Association will assign personnel to collect the artworks at the schools). When submitting the physical works, please do not write personal information on the front/back of the works. Attach the entry form to the back of the work and package it in a sealed bag.
- 11. Primary selection date : November, 15 (the list of selected works will be announced on November, 20)

Final Selection date : November, 23 (the list of award winners will be announced in late November)

- 12. Announcement of selected and award winning works : The list of selected and award winning works will be announced on Macao Government Tourism Office webpage https://fireworks.macaotourism.gov.mo/index.php and Macau Artist Society webpage http://masmacau.com/, as well as the Macau Artist Society's Facebook Page.
