Theme


"Macao in My Eyes" or "The Future Macao".



Submission of Entry

Students must enter the contest as individual entrants. Please take a photo or scan your artwork in JPG format and submit the high-resolution image (file size: at least 2MB, max. 5MB), along with the entry form by email to macauyouthart@gmail.com, on or before 4 November 2024. A confirmation reply will be sent by the organiser upon receiving the submission. Complaints regarding lost submissions due to oversized attachments will not be accepted.

Number of **Entries**

Each entrant can only submit ONE entry.

Jury

Jury consist of professionals from various art and culture industries.

Assessment Criteria

1. A First, Second, and Third place for each category: 100% Jury decision (complying with the theme 40%, aesthetic appeal 30%, creativity 30%)

- 2. Excellence Award for each category: 50% Jury decision (complying with the theme 40%, aesthetic appeal 30%, creativity 30%) + 50% on-site vote
- 3. Best Vibe Award across all categories: 100% on-site vote
- 4. If the entries fail to meet the award requirements after being reviewed, the prize may not be awarded.
- 5. The jury's decision is final and no appeals will be considered.

Evaluation Procedures

The submitted artworks will undergo two rounds of selection. Upon passing the initial round, the Macao Youth Art Association will notify the respective students via phone or email to submit their physical artwork entry either to the Macau Youth Art Association office (Address: Avenida do Conselheiro Ferreira de Almeida No. 49, Edifício SAN HEI KOC FL1 FLAT C, D, Macao; Office hours: Monday to Friday, 10:00a.m. to 5:00p.m.) or collectively at their schools (where Macau Youth Art Association personnel will be designated to collect the entries).

*Please refrain from including personal information on the front or back of the entry. Kindly affix the entry form to the back of the entry artwork and enclose it in a sealed bag during submission. The results of the initial round of selection and the list of selected entries will be announced by early November on the Macao Youth Art Association webpage at http://macauyouthart.com and on its Facebook page.

Showcase of Physical Works From late November 2024, shortlisted works from each category will be showcased in the "Macao Artistry" section of the "Macao's Resonance: A Sensory Re-imagination Exhibition", which is held at R39, 1st Floor, H853 Fun Factory, Lisboeta Macau, open to the public with free admission and featuring an on-site audience vote. Winners will be invited to an awards ceremony tentatively scheduled for the afternoon of 8 December 2024.



Best Good-feel Award	A trophy, and cash vouchers or gifts.		


Other Terms and Conditions

In the event of infringement on the copyright, patent, or other rights of a third party, the organiser reserves the right to disqualfy competitors and seek compensation and such winners are required to return any prizes, trophies, and certificates awarded, while assuming full legal responsibilities.
- 4. The submitted entry must not contain any violent, obscene, pornographic, defamatory, morally questionable, insulting, controversial, or inappropriate content.
- 5. For the sake of fairness, members of the jury and their immediate family members are not allowed to participate in this event. The artworks will be shown after the jury's selection.
- 6. Upon submission of the entry, all participants acknowledge and accept

Yet proper crediting of the authors' names shall be ensured.


